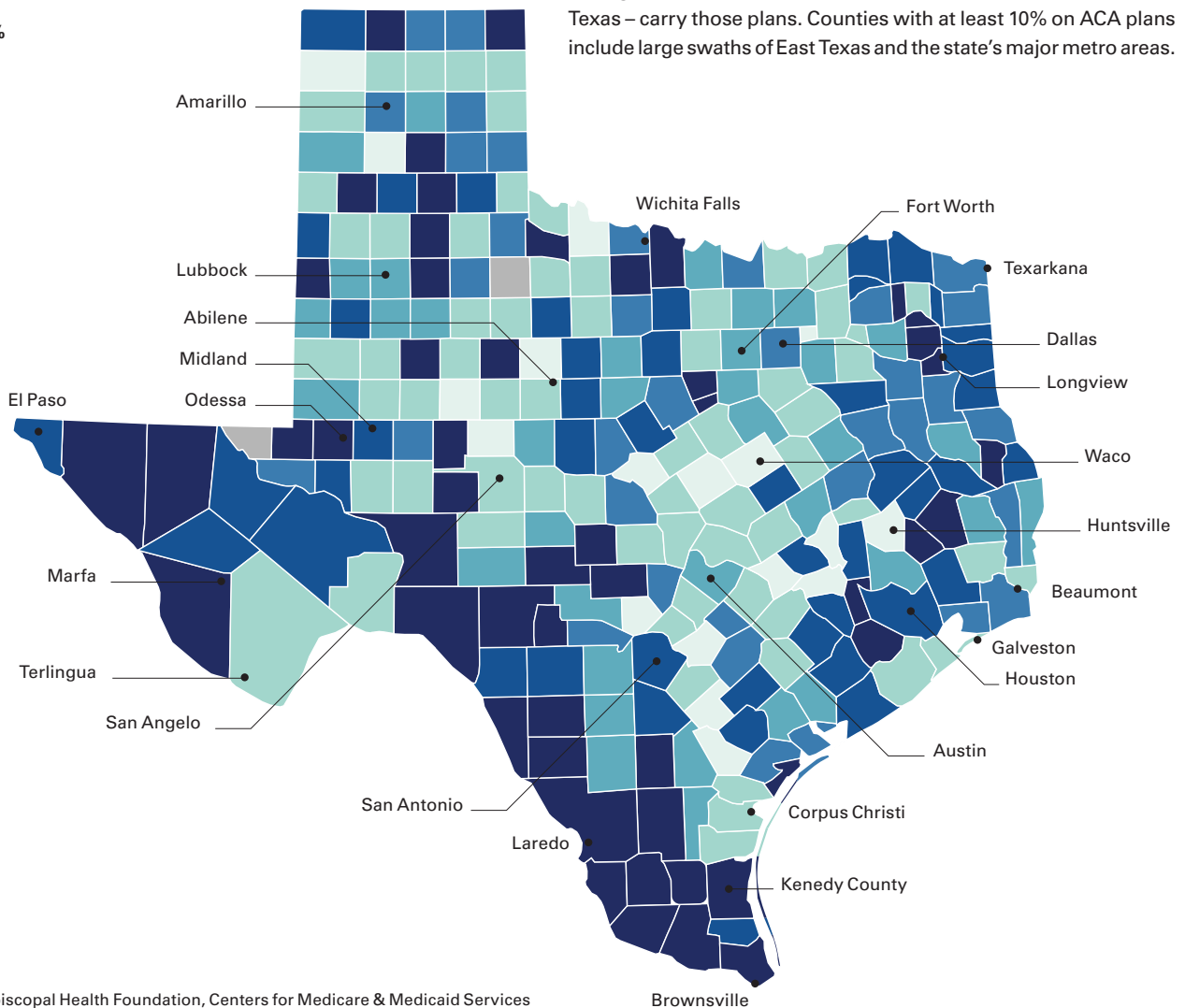


### ACA IN TEXAS

A significant number of Texans get health care coverage through Affordable Care Act (ACA) marketplace health plans – especially in rural and underserved parts of the state. In sparsely populated Kenedy County, nearly 80% of people carry ACA health plans, and as this state map illustrates, more than 15% of the population in counties throughout the state – with concentrations in South Texas and West Texas – carry those plans. Counties with at least 10% on ACA plans include large swaths of East Texas and the state’s major metro areas.
