A lot happens at TexMed each year in addition to business meetings:

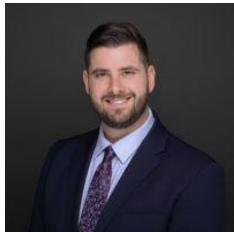
- Explore more than 35 hours of CME on Friday and Saturday
