

Malpractice Insurance requirements changing in 2021

This information applies to health care professionals in Kansas, Michigan, Missouri, Mississippi, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania and Texas

Beginning March 1, 2021, UnitedHealthcare is increasing the minimum amounts of malpractice (professional liability) insurance that health care professionals are required to carry to meet our credentialing and recredentialing requirements. Please review the information below and ensure you adjust your insurance coverage, if needed. We will ask for proof of insurance during your normal recredentialing cycle.
