8 IN 10 KIDS WHO DIED OF FLU IN 2017-18 DIDN'T GET THE FLU SHOT

Vaccines protect kids from **14 serious diseases.**

Some of these diseases cause lasting health problems, like **deafness or brain damage, and even death.**

The rotavirus vaccine became available in 2006, keeping **40,000-50,000 U.S. kids out of the hospital** each year for severe diarrhea.

Vaccines can even stop diseases. Because so many people got the smallpox shot to stop its spread, the disease is now gone.

BONUS PROTECTION

Vaccines protect more than the kids who get them. Vaccinations help your kids stay healthy so they don't pass an illness to someone who can't fight it, like a grandparent or classmate who has a medical problem.

VACCINATIONS KIDS NEED

Getting vaccinations at the ages doctors recommend is best. Experts time them when the kids are most at risk for a disease and when their bodies can best build a defense against germs. Getting several vaccines at a time is safe.

The chart below shows what vaccinations your child needs and when.

Recibir vacunas a la edad recomendada por los médicos es lo mejor. De esta manera los expertos monitorean cuando los niños tienen más riesgo de una enfermedad y cuando sus cuerpos pueden construir una mejor defensa contra los gérmenes.
